Short term Observer ship in Ophthalmology

- **1. Aim and objective**: The aim and objective of Observership opportunity by the Department of ophthalmology is to improve clinical skills of general ophthalmologists in examination of paediatric patients.
- **2.** Eligibility– M.S (Ophthalmology)/ DOMS, PG students first year onwards.
- **3. Intake** maximum 1 Candidate in a cycle .Up to 6 Cycles per year maximum.
- **4. Duration** 4 weeks; Fee- Rs. 1000/-
- **5.** No stipend will be paid to the candidate. The common guidelines relevant to observership programs released by PGICH Noida from time to time shall remain applicable.
- **6. Procedure** Candidates interested to apply for observership shall be required to submit Application and Bio data to e-mail: ophthapgich@gmail.com.
- **7. Accommodation** Hostel accommodation may be allotted on prior information and subject to availability as per institute rules.
- **8. Dates of the observer ship**: mutually agreed upon by the candidate and department and observership will be certified at the end of program
 - Interested Candidates will be given the opportunity to observe basic and advanced skills of examination of paediatric patients. Special emphasis will be given on ROP screening of premature paediatric patients. As a part of this, they will only observe the process and procedures without any signing authority.
 - The observers will be given an opportunity to learn from various sections in the department such as refraction, ultrasound biomicroscopy, green laser photocoagulation, ROP screening. The observer will be allowed in OT also to observe specialised paediatric operative procedures like Lasers for ROP, intravitreal Anti VEGF injections for ROP, Squint surgery, ptosis surgery, cataract surgery and glaucoma surgery of paediatric patients.
 - Pre-Test at the beginning of the course & Post-Test at the end of course will be done.
